



Each department is challenged to see who can receive the highest participation of employees who give to the campaign. Plus, the department with the most overall participation will also receive the coveted **LEADING THE WAY TROPHY** to proudly display in their area!

Some things to note:

- To ensure enough individuals per department, some departments will be grouped together (please see below how departments will be grouped).
- This is not about total funds raised by departments, but rather total amount of individuals that participate in your department. Every dollar counts and everyone makes a difference! However, if there is a tie (i.e. multiple departments earn 100% participation), each department will receive a catered lunch and the tiebreaker for the trophy will then be the total amount of funds donated.
